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UH Transfer Rules

- Courses taken at HCC must be completed with a C- or better.
- A maximum of 66 lower-level transfer credits can be used towards a UH bachelor's degree.
- A maximum of 2 credit hours in physical activity courses can transfer.

Major Requirements

- **B.S. Math:** complete 12 hours of approved mathematics courses. Students majoring in Exercise Science – Health Professions will fulfill this requirement through major coursework.
- **B.S. Natural Science:** complete 8 hours of science courses. Students majoring in Exercise Science – Health Professions will fulfill this requirement through major coursework.
- Complete KINE 1301, KIN 2304, KIN 3304, KIN 3306, KIN 3309, KIN 4310, and KIN 4370 with a C- or better.
- This major does not require a CLASS Diversity course, CLASS Block courses, or a minor.

From CLASS to Careers

Students who graduate with a degree in Kinesiology can pursue a large variety of careers and graduate programs. Recent graduates are employed in the following careers:
