### **UH Transfer Rules**

- Courses taken at SJC must be completed with a C- or better.
- A maximum of 66 lower-level transfer credits can be used towards a UH bachelor's degree.
- A maximum of 2 credit hours in physical activity courses can transfer.

## **Major Requirements**

- B.S. Math: complete 12 hours of approved mathematics courses.
   Approved mathematics courses include: BUSI 2305, COSC 1436, all college-level MATH courses, PHIL 2303, or PSYC 2317.
   At least 6 hours must be MATH courses
- **B.S. Natural Science**: complete 8 hours of core Life & Physical Science courses.
- Two of the three minors must be CLASS minors. One minor can be selected from all eligible programs of UH colleges, including those that are outside of CLASS.
- Courses taken for one minor cannot be used to satisfy requirements in either of the other two minors.
- The CLASS Block and CLASS Diversity requirements are not required for the Liberal Studies major.

Students who graduate with a degree in Liberal Studies can pursue a large variety of careers and graduate programs. Recent graduates are employed in the following careers:
