Request #1 – Service Nights One Time Request

MVP Service Nights are a unique opportunity to bring meaningful service projects to campus, ultimately allowing a larger number of students to give back to the Houston community. These events are designed to allow students to volunteer within a 2 hour timeframe and eliminate the barrier of needing to provide transportation to a service site. A total of 364 students participated in 6 Service Nights during FY16, with each Service Night averaging at least 60 students including one of the events reaching over 100 student volunteers in one evening. Students have the opportunity to complete a variety of project including making sandwiches and blankets for local organizations to give to people who are homeless.

We are requesting one time funding in order to purchase enough supplies to hold this event approximately 8 times this upcoming year. MVP continues to work closely with our community partners to identify additional projects that will support their efforts and can be completed on campus, allowing the Service Nights to grow and meet the demand from student volunteers. The Service Night events have turned into a great opportunity for collaborations with both student organizations and departments. Currently planned collaborations for the year include the Center for Fraternity and Sorority Life, the Black Student Union, Student Government Association, Phi Alpha Delta, the Pre-Pharmacy Association, and the Council for Ethnic Organizations. Request #2 – Volunteer Fairs One Time Request

MVP hosts a Volunteer Fair each semester to connect students at the University of Houston with local charities and non-profit agencies that are in need of volunteers. Each semester, MVP supports approximately 35 local non-profit agencies as they spread awareness about volunteer opportunities in the Third Ward and Houston community. For FY18 we plan to increase our marketing to engage more of the student population. We are requesting \$5,936.00 to market the event, accommodate community partners, and purchase supplies. We will also rent eight 20'x10' tents both semesters.

In FY16, MVP was able to sustain a combined total attendance of over 1,130 students at each Volunteer Fair, a 182.5% increase in the attendance since FY13. This exponential growth has only been made possible through the financial support from SFAC.
