


MISSIONSTATEMENT




EXECUTIVE BRANCH

The Executive Power of SGA is vested in the elected Student Body President and Vice-President. The Cabinet is appointed by the President and confirmed by the Senate. Executive members work on multiple large initiatives throughout the year.



LEGISLATIVE BRANCH

The legislative power of SGA is vested in the Student Senate. Senators write legislation and work on initiatives, often related to the college that they represent.



JUDICIAL BRANCH

The Judicial Branch of SGA hears matters involving the constitutionality of legislation, disputes between branches, and election complaints.

Ensured contract timeframe is 5 years instead of 20 years to avoid complacency


Parking 53rd Administration
