To increase efficiency and provide a secure unified portal, CSD has been exploring AIM. Accessible Information Management (AIM) is an online platform that makes it easy for students to view, manage and request accommodations through Student Disability Services. It is a comprehensive accommodation, appointment, and case management software built by disability services professionals, for disability services departments. Through AIM, students (as well as a physician’s office or another school) can also upload required documentation, upload and download class notes, schedule an exam and more, and is a best practice used by the University of Arizona and Johns Hopkins University.

One-time implementation costs include system set up, data importation, and remote training are \$11,250.00. The annual cost is \$18,400.00.
